



Farm Rules

WARNING!

Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

1. Please communicate directly with Amber George about any changes you need to make about your horses' care. This includes such things as feed changes, turnout changes, blanketing, hay requirements, etc.
2. Please be courteous of the horses & HCF's residents when you must be at the farm before 7:00 am or after 9:00 pm. Arena lights are NOT to remain on after 10 p.m. Activity in the barn must be finished by 10:30 p.m.
3. All Trainers/Guest Riders/ Students/ Boarders must sign a liability release in order to ride & handle horses at HCF.
4. All horses must have a negative coggins test, dated within 12 months. Proof of this must be presented upon signing a boarding contract.
5. Boarders agree to follow HCF worming program. Please speak with Amber for further information.
6. HCF strongly recommends wearing ASTM approved helmets whenever mounted.
7. Help keep grooming areas/ wash stalls free of clutter. Clean up after your horse and remember to put your things away. This responsibility lies with the owner of the horse. Trash cans can be easily located at HCF and are there for everyone's use.
8. Remember that many boarders share the tack rooms. Be courteous & keep your things tidy.
9. Horse boarders are responsible for the upkeep other than stall cleaning, feeding, & turn/out.
10. Horse boarders may not enter the stalls of any other horse or handle other's horses unless arrangements have been made with those horse owners.
11. Horses must be attended (owner must be present) when tied. Horses will only be tied in designated locations. NO TYING to stall bars, unless using a hay string.
12. Boarders are responsible for paying for any damage caused by your horse that is not due to normal wear.
13. Try to keep glass containers outside of the farm. Broken glass can be very hazardous to the animals as well as other people.
14. Borrow equipment/ tack only if you have the owner's permission. Please return it in the same or better condition than when it was loaned to you, & please return it to its proper place.
15. Dogs are allowed if they do not disrupt HCF. Owners are responsible for their own dogs. Please see Amber before bringing your dog out to the farm to discuss appropriate behavior & conduct.
16. Small children need to be closely attended.
17. Stalls must be kept latched at all times.
18. Remember to use the buddy system when trail riding! Inform an adult of where you will be riding.
19. Common sense security measures will be followed to prevent vandalism and theft.
20. Boarders are required to use main drive/ lower drive entrance and drive no faster than 15 mph. We have many dogs, horses, deer, squirrels, cyclists, pedestrians, etc that share our driveway & trails. Please be slow & cautious!
21. Please respect our beautiful farm & help keep it beautiful. Dispose of trash properly.
22. A thirty day notice is required when moving your horse away from the premises
23. **NO DRUGS! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
24. **No excessive use of Alcohol allowed on the premises.**
25. **No firearms allowed on the premises.**
26. **No smoking on premises.**
